Greetings believers,

Hope you had a blessed feast of Passover/Unleavened Bread. I know that those of you who live in the extreme north or south have not seen/felt the benefit of lengthening days as those of us living nearer the equator, but spring has definitely sprung. Right on time, as it always does.

A number of you still questioned that I am calling this the month of Abib. Friends, I am not announcing Abib without due cause. Nature is calling this the month of Abib, I am merely identifying what nature is announcing. Scripture calls the month that the barley is harvested in the Middle East the month of Abib. Since as of 3-7-2019 NATURE has produced ripe barley in Israel and if Abib is the name of month in Scripture when barely is found ripe, then what am I missing? Or, better yet, what are you missing?

Scripture and nature do not lie. Please re-read that last sentence, a few dozen times if you must. Nature is the first gospel. All nature screams the majesty of YHWH. When your theology does not line up with Scripture or nature, your theology is in error. When this is discovered, you must do what every truth seeker has done before you...change your theology.

"It is not the truth that hurts us. It is that we have been taught (and believed) so many things that are NOT true" *Phil Wilson*

At least here, there will be a 2 day New Moon coming at the end of this month. Depending on where you live in correlation to last New Moon and this New Moon, you may have only ONE day of New Moon where you are, but nearly everyone will enjoy a 2 day New Moon.

Conjunction will occur april 5, 2019, over the far western Pacific, north of Malaysia. The first crescent will not be seen until nearly 19 hours later in the eastern Pacific (southeast of Hawaii, west of Ecuador). A few islands in the South Pacific east of the international dateline will be able to see the first crescent, which announces the end of New Moon, on 4-5-2019. Everyone else will see it on 4-6-2019.

I say everyone else, meaning those closer to the equator. And something that I have not mentioned in a while, if, for instance someone in the middle of the USA can see the signal to begin the work week (the first crescent), but someone due north of them in northern Canada cannot, the Canadian should follow the eye-witness of his neighbor in the USA. Likewise, if someone in Israel can see the

signal to begin the work week, but someone due south of them in South Africa cannot, those in South Africa would do well to follow the eyewitness of their neighbor in Israel. Why? Because a week later, when the moon is well above the horizon, everyone on the same longitudinal line will see the quarter phases of the moon on the SAME date. If you want to keep pace with the quarter phases, then if you cannot see the signals for yourself, you must pay attention to the eyewitness of those between you and the equator.

Those in the extreme north and south can (will and do) miss the signals seen in the heavens that Lunar Sabbatarians closer to the equator can easily see. It is all a matter of nearness to the event and perspective. Someone on the front row of a concert can see everything there is to see, much better than someone in the back row. But BOTH can see better than someone who is not even in the same building.

Friends, TALK to your Lunar Sabbath friends and family. Let them know what you see and when you see it. It is in this manner that we will create a world community. While we are able to communicate freely, we must take advantage of this ability as long as it is available to us.

Other than the few islands in the south Pacific (who will be a day earlier than the dates that follow), the moon will announce the weekly Sabbaths on 4-13, 4-20, 4-27 and 5-4-2019.

I just have no idea who or where they are. We are not alone, and our ranks are swelling. The Father is collecting His remnant as we speak. \o/ HalleluYah! \o/

Training for the newbies:

The idea for this newsletter is to teach you how to read the clock in the heavens for yourself. There are a handful of us who have been observing the Creation Calendar for 10-15 years or more giving us insight by experience. If you have no intention of learning how to read the clock in the heavens for yourself, please let me know so I can remove your e-mail from this list. You cannot get to the kingdom on my coat tails, nor can you ever understand the Father's calendar by leaning on the arm of flesh (in this case, mine). The idea is to teach you how to read the calendar in the heavens for yourself because we will not always be able to communicate in this fashion, where those of us who have been doing this for many years can show you what to watch for. PLEASE, if you are able, go outside and look up at the Father's time pieces for yourself. There is no better teacher than experience. Indeed, there are those who live where the horizons are not available to them due to buildings, mountains, pollution, etc. But everyone can and SHOULD see the first and third quarter phase moon as they are overhead in the sky. I have traveled several miles before for the possibility of seeing the moon. Make the effort. Watch and learn...

Please note that all dates in parentheses are Gregorian time, all other numbered days or dates are Creation Calendar time. Please also note that if you live south of the equator, you will look face north to look for the moon, but the times and dates below will be the same. If you need to, print this out so you can look at it while looking for the moon.

The calendar model below is the only one that lines up with all the calendar evidence in Scripture with nature, without force or prejudice.

The 1st day (4-6-2019) is New Moon Day: New Moon Day is a convocation day, not a Sabbath. Only the seventh New Moon is a Sabbath, the Feast of Trumpets. In the evening at the end of this day, you will see the first new waxing crescent moon (a thin sliver) low in the western sky just after sunset. This first crescent announces the end of the New Moon phase and that day 2 of the month (the first work day of the week) will begin at dawn the following morning.

The 8th day (4-13-2019) is the First Sabbath of the Lunar Month: The First Quarter Phase appears at sunset on the evening of the 7th day of the month (4-12-2019). This quarter phase announces that the 8th day is the Sabbath. In the north of the equator if you are facing south, the moon will be seen overhead at sunset. This is the waxing first quarter moon which can be slightly convex or concave, but most importantly--with the flat side perpendicular to the earth.

The 15th day (4-20-2019) is the Second Sabbath of the Lunar Month: The Full Moon can be seen rising in the eastern sky about the time the sun sets in the west on the 14th day of the lunar month (4-19-2019). This full moon announces the 15th day of the lunar month as the Sabbath. The same day the moon becomes full, it starts waning. The moon can look full for 2-3 days but there is only ONE full moon. The real full moon <u>normally</u> rises at or after sunset.

The 22nd day (4-27-2019) is the Third Sabbath of the Lunar Month: The Third Quarter (aka Last Quarter) phase is a waning quarter moon which can be slightly convex or concave--but most importantly, with the flat side perpendicular to the earth. It can be seen early in the morning, at the rising of the sun the moon will be directly overhead, straight up if you are in the northern hemisphere and facing south. Reason--the moon is moving at right angles to the earth every quarter, so the moon at sunset on the 21st day of the lunar month will be on the other side of the earth from the viewer. If you wait until dawn, however, the third quarter moon will be seen before the Sabbath begins at dawn. This announces the 22nd day of the lunar month as a Sabbath day.

The 29th day (5-4-2019) is the Last Sabbath of the Lunar Month: The Waning Sliver, just prior to conjunction, can sometimes be seen but it will be lost in the sun's glare at other times. If you don't see it, watch each evening at sunset until you see the new thin crescent low in the western sky at sunset announcing the first work day. It will only be one or two days until you see the New crescent. Thus, the Sabbaths moons are seen before the Sabbath begins. The first two will be seen at sunset the evening before, the last two will be seen in position at dawn before the Sabbath begins.

The 30th day--1st day: The 30th day of a lunar month (if it is a 30 day month) is part of the New Moon celebration--no moon is seen that day. This is also the dark phase of the moon. New Moon counts as neither as one of the 6 work days nor a Sabbath. It is a third category of day. There will be no day 30 in a 29-day month. Both day 30 and day 1 of the month are part of a New Moon celebration. No moon will be seen to announce either day, morning or evening. So there are either one or two new moon days each month. The 29th or 30th day ends the previous month and the 1st begins every new month. On the evening of the 1st day, the first new crescent (waxing sliver) can be seen about 35 to 45 minutes after sunset just to the left of where the sun went down, low in the western sky. This announces the beginning of day 2 of the new month, which is the first work day of the first week of the new month.

Days 2 through day 7 are work days; the eighth day is the Sabbath. New moon day does not count against the week. Days 2-8 of the month are the 7 days of the first week. Please note that the Sabbath is STILL and always has been the seventh day of the week, every week, however, these Sabbath days are the 8th, 15th, 22nd and 29th days of each month. New Moon Days require a convocation with YHWH (short worship service, see **Isaiah 66:23**) but are not Sabbaths, with the exception of the seventh New Moon, the Feast of Trumpets.

New Moon Days are worship days but are not Sabbath days of rest (except the 7th New Moon--Feast of Trumpets). They are separate. Yah's Word verifies the 8th, 15th, 22nd and 29th days are Sabbath days. The ancient Tabernacle gates were open only on the New Moon Days and the Sabbath days (**Ezekiel 46:1**). People worshiped at the outer gate of the Tabernacle on their worship days, the new moons and Sabbath days (**Amos 8:5**, **Isaiah 66:23**, **II Kings 4:23**). There is a set-apart convocation on New Moon, but the entire day is not "set-apart" as is the weekly Sabbath. The one exception is the seventh New Moon mentioned above. Feast of Trumpets (the seventh New Moon) is treated as a weekly Sabbath.
